#### Mandatory Vaccinations.

As you are aware from January 1st 2022 all staff and adults working or volunteering at school need to be fully vaccinated. There are also lots of as yet unanswered questions in and around parent involvement at school and whether they need to be fully vaccinated, for example, parents helping on a school trip or coaching school teams. There are lots of other examples. As yet I have had no guidance on this from the Ministry, though I am assured it is coming. I will let you know as soon as I know. The only decision we have made on advice from the Ministry is that any parents volunteering to help on our school camps next year will need to be fully vaccinated.

We have lots of events coming up this term that may be affected by Level 2 restrictions, for example, graduation ceremonies. At this stage I am waiting to see what transpires over the next few
