Positive tests

Last week I sent out the processes our school will undertake if we have a positive COVID case. I have had an update from the Ministry in regards to this. If I am informed of a positive case/close contact outside of school hours then all classes concerned will be notified by email and from that day you will need to self-isolate and get a test. If I am informed during school hours then all parents of the affected classrooms will be rung or emailed. All children will need to be picked up from school as soon as possible. If that is not possible then the children will remain in the class with their teacher and will effectively be isolated from the rest of the school. I know this sounds a bit extreme but I have to follow the Government guidelines. Thanks for all the support we have received so far during this difficult time, it is most appreciated.
